3B construction have worked through all weathers to ensure that the timetable of work has kept to plan, with completion date scheduled for the end of August.

Over the last few weeks the roof on the new build has been completed, while alongside the roof of the existing hall has been strengthened and solar panels fitted.

The inside of the new Annexe is starting to take shape and it is now easy to visualise all the spaces inside.

The existing building will close on Monday 16th June for an estimated 5-week period to allow refurbishment of the hall and to join the new Annexe and existing building together. During this time no entry to the hall will be permitted.

The Board of Directors and sub-groups are now making final decisions on fixtures and fittings, and will shortly begin the recruitment procedure for new staff.
